Show and Tell


Join us on our private Facebook page for show and tell! This week's letter and sound is Q.

Little lamb likes to play hide and seek with all
the other lambs, he goes to the edge of the
field and sees another field beyond with
different animals!



Suggested activities





Create a simple little chick either using some paper or card and working on those scissor skills or use a fork and some paint!

Make a lamb – use cotton wool or even cut up little bits of paper which can be glued on - great for fine motor skills!





Or some finger print lambs!

Footprint puppies!! - A sensory activity, a little bit messy but lots of fun – enjoy the tickly feeling on the bottom of your feet and toes!





Let's use up those toilet roll holders by creating some baby farm animals!



Matching activity - Animals and their young matching cards

<u>Cutting activity</u> - Animals and their young - The animals have lost their babies! Can you cut out the mother and baby animals, match them up and stick them on the farm?

<u>Pencil control</u> - Animals and their young matching sheets – join each animal to its baby

Colouring – Baby animal colouring sheets

Pencil control - Farm animals and their babies picture matching activity

<u>Matching activity</u> – Beautiful images of jungle animals and their young to support learning about unusual animals and their babies

<u>Cutting, matching and sticking activity</u> - Mothers and their young – cut out the baby animal pictures and match and stick them next to their mummies!

<u>Matching activity on the farm</u> – Lovely images of farm animals to match

Colouring – mummy giraffe and her calf colouring sheet

What can you see? - baby animals hide and seek PowerPoint activity

<u>Animals and their young families</u> – Explore and talk about some stunning images of animals with their young

<u>CBeebies Andy's Baby Animals</u> - Join Andy as he explores how baby animals learn skills such as climbing, swimming and getting around.

<u>Music and movement</u> – The baby animal song!

<u>Baby animals</u> – a little video to learn all about baby animal names and their sounds
